## **Grand River Rafting Company – Turbo Tube Trip Details**

## **Trip Description**

The Paris to Brant Park trip is 13 km long (8 miles). The trip takes approximately 4 hours to complete. The last mile of the trip requires paddling.

This event is open for members only.

Each member will be given a turbo tube and a life jacket for their trip. One member per tube.

No alcohol or glass containers are allowed on the boat. The Grand River Rafting Company reserves the right to search bags before your trip departure.

There are picnic stops and portable washrooms at the 9 km mark on this route.

## **How Your Trip Works**

- 1. Arrive at the Brant Conservation Area, 119 Jennings Road Brantford, thirty (30) minutes prior to your time slot.
- You will be emailed a reservation code that you give the entrance gate attendant.
   This allows for free parking at the conservation area. Follow the signs down to the river and find the Grand River Rafting Company area.
- 3. Upon arrival, park your vehicle. You will be outfitted with a life jacket.
- 4. Once everyone is ready... you will be shuttle bused to the Paris launch site... you get your tube... then paddle down the river to the exit point where your vehicle is parked.
- 5. At the end of the trip lunch will be provided. Please go to site #187 located down the road from parking.

## What to Bring:

- 1. Good sunscreen, hat, sun glasses, retainer string for eye glasses, water & snacks, gloves if hands blister easily, lip balm. Water refill stations are available for bring-your-own-water bottle.
- 2. Bring footwear you don't mind getting wet... the river bottom is rocky.
- 3. If you burn easy... long sleeves and pants... otherwise swim suits or clothes that dry quickly. Denim jeans are not a good idea... they stay wet forever!
- 4. Due to health protocols we are not supplying dry bags... so please bring ziplock bags or bags capable of keeping car keys, cell phones and personals dry
